GIRLS EXPLORING SCIENCE, TECHNOLOGY, ENGINEERING, AND MATH (GESTEM)

For the past several years, Carollo's Denver offices continue to host a "Working Wonders with Water" workshop at the Girls Exploring Science, Technology, Engineering, and Math (GESTEM) event. GESTEM is a free, annual event held in Denver specifically for 7th grade girls and is geared to inspiring them by introducing them to career opportunities in science, technology, engineering, and math fields. Participants engage with local STEM professionals in three hands-on workshops where they have the opportunity to learn about STEM careers in a fun and interactive environment. Carollo's workshop involves a water treatment presentation, treated water sample jar testing, and a hands-on activity where students make water filters. To initiate the competition, the students compare results by testing the turbidity (i.e., cloudiness) of their filtered water. A handful of local water and wastewater utilities also participate and donate supplies contributing to the workshops' success.

STEM SUPPORT IN LOCAL CLASSROOMS

Carollo Engineers continues its commitment to support local educators with collaboration in the classroom. These on-site visits by our engineers provide a venue for students, educators, and professionals to demonstrate programs, projects and practices in an effort to enrich STEM education. Our programs include lessons and hands-on activities to teach students about water and wastewater treatment, the water cycle, and water conservation. We strive to inspire students to become innovative and creative thinkers by fostering excitement and interest in the fields of science, technology and engineering.



INTERNSHIP AND JOB SHADOWING FOR HIGH SCHOOL STUDENTS

Carollo supports the Denver's Legacy 2000 job shadowing and internship program. Legacy 2000 is designed for students who have an interest and ability in science, technology, engineering, and math (STEM). Students focus on technical writing, research, public speaking and networking, all in an environment of rigorous expectations and professionalism. L2k students go on to complete a 20-hour job shadow during their junior year and a 40-hour internship during their senior year in a field in which the students have interest. Carollo most recently hosted a student who had the opportunity to work alongside engineering and CAD staff and gained practical experience in 3D modeling.
