Orange County Children's Water Education Festival

The Orange County Carollo Cares Team participates in the annual Orange County Children's Water Education Festival presented by the Orange County Water District and hosted at University of California, Irvine. During the two-day event, hundreds of students, grades 3 to 5, participated in activities and presentations to learn about local water issues and the environment. Carollo Cares hosted an activity alongside representatives from various other organizations including clients (OCWD, OCSAN, MWD, and many more), other consulting firms, and even the Disneyland Resort.

Carollo hosted a fun activity where the kids got to build simple, small-scale water filters using gravel, sand and cotton balls. Each group spent 20 minutes at our booth where we talked to them about water filters, walked them through the process of building their own filter and then tested their filters. The kids had fun and learned a lot about water and water filters. Over the two-day event, nearly 400 kids participated in our Carollo Cares water filter activity.

Elementary School Visits

Carollo Engineers continues its commitment to support local educators with collaboration in the classroom. These on-site visits by our engineers provide a venue for students, educators, and professionals to demonstrate programs, projects and practices in an effort to enrich STEM education. Our program at Van Buren Elementary School includes lessons and hands-on activities to teach students about water and wastewater treatment, the water cycle, and water conservation. We strive to inspire students to become innovative and creative thinkers by fostering excitement and interest in the fields of science, technology and engineering.



San Diego STEAM: Women Who Inspire Conference

On March 8th, International Women's Day, Carollo Engineers headed to San Diego to speak at the Women Who Inspire Conference. This event hosted more than 200 high school students from underserved schools in the San Diego Area.
